


- Sample questions for practice- You will receive a confirmation email to access the sample questions.

First Day of the Exam

Friday, July 8, 2016

- Log into Blackboard, read official questions. Choose <u>one</u> to answer
- Write your research paper in MS-Word
 - File name: <your test ID> Question< # >.doc or .docx or .pdf
 - 12 pt. font, double-spaced, 1-inch margins
 - Comps essay length range of 2000-2500
 - No personally identifying information
- Work where you want
- You are responsible for network connections, saving your work, etc. You will not receive extra time for these problems unless there is a campus-wide problem.

Essay Questions - SAMPLE

NOTE: These are sample questions.

Choose **ONE** of the following questions and write your essay:

1) In pursuit of their mission in a changing environment, libraries, archives and similar organizations are undertaking collaborative initiatives to tackle common challenges. For a library, archive or information center of your choice, identify one organization they could partner with to achieve common goals or address common challenges. Describe one collaborative initiative they could undertake. Explain how the initiative will advance the mission of each partner. Identify two critical issues in the planning process for the collaboration and discuss how the partners can address the two issues to ensure success of their collaborative effort. Include references to the literature as appropriate.

2) One important consideration in the creation of a digital collection is the selection and implementation of an appropriate metadata scheme. Explain why metadata is important and what roles a metadata scheme plays in creating and maintaining a digital collection. Discuss three issues digital collection librarians should consider in selecting and implementing a metadata scheme. Include references to the literature as appropriate.


Submitting your exam
